18		In part one of the assignment there are at least six passages from the novel chosen for the project. Each of the passages is at least two sentences long, and all six are copied into the project exactly as they appear in the book. Page numbers are cited.
30		In part one of the assignment, each of the six chosen passages includes a reaction to the passage that is at least one paragraph long. Each of the reaction paragraphs is a well-written paragraph of at least seven sentences.
10		In part two of the assignment, a different passage from the six passages chosen in part one has been chosen and quoted exactly as it appears in the book. Page numbers are cited.
25		In part two of the assignment, a full paragraph (of seven or more sentences) explains why the passage chosen for part two represents the book as a whole and why it serves as “the quote of the book.”
30		The reflective letter portion of the assignment is at about one page long. It focuses on recording the student’s thoughts, feelings, and observations about the novel and the assignment. It goes further than just stating whether or not the student did or did not like the novel.
12		The entire project is typed according to MLA format (including the name heading, the header with name and page number reflected, double-spaced, one-inch margins, and Times New Roman size 12 font).
